

ST. LOUIS ATTRACTIONS - HIGHLIGHTS

1 Anheuser-Busch Brewery 314-577-2626

2 hour tours of the brewery and vintage complex, 7 days a week, Admission Free. Includes the Clydesdale stables.

2 City Museum and Aquarium 314-231-2489

Truly a unique experience. Requires 4 hours to cover 3 floors of exhibits indoors and outdoors. Admission \$12 plus \$3 parking.

3 Gateway Arch & Museum 314-655-1700

The 630 foot arch, tallest man made monument. Admission to arch \$7. Admission to Museum is free. Open Daily 8am-10pm.

4 Missouri Botanical Gardens 314-577-9400

79 acres of formal gardens, conservatories, rainforest, temperate house, sculptures, Japanese Garden and special exhibits. Open daily from 9am to 5pm. Admission \$8.

5 St. Louis Zoo 314-781-0900

90 acres with over 6,000 animals. One of the worlds best zoos, admission is free. Special children's zoo admission is \$4.

6 St. Louis Art Museum 314-721-0072

Built for the 1904 Worlds Fair, one of the top Art Museums in the country, features nearly every period and national origin, and outstanding art work from 1800. Admission is free, special exhibits cost extra. Open 7 days from 10am to 9pm.

7 Grant's Farm 314-843-1700

This Busch family estate is a wildlife preserve with an open tram ride around the park. Park is 281 acres with over 1,000 animals. Admission is \$10 per car for parking.

8 St. Louis Science Center 314-289-4444

Explore over 700 hands on exhibits, admission is free. The Omni Max and special exhibits have a fee.

9 St. Louis Baseball Cardinals 314-421-3060

For June 13-14-15 cardinals are playing the Phil. Phillies. Good seats for each game Are still available.

10 Historic St. Charles Main Street 636-946-7776

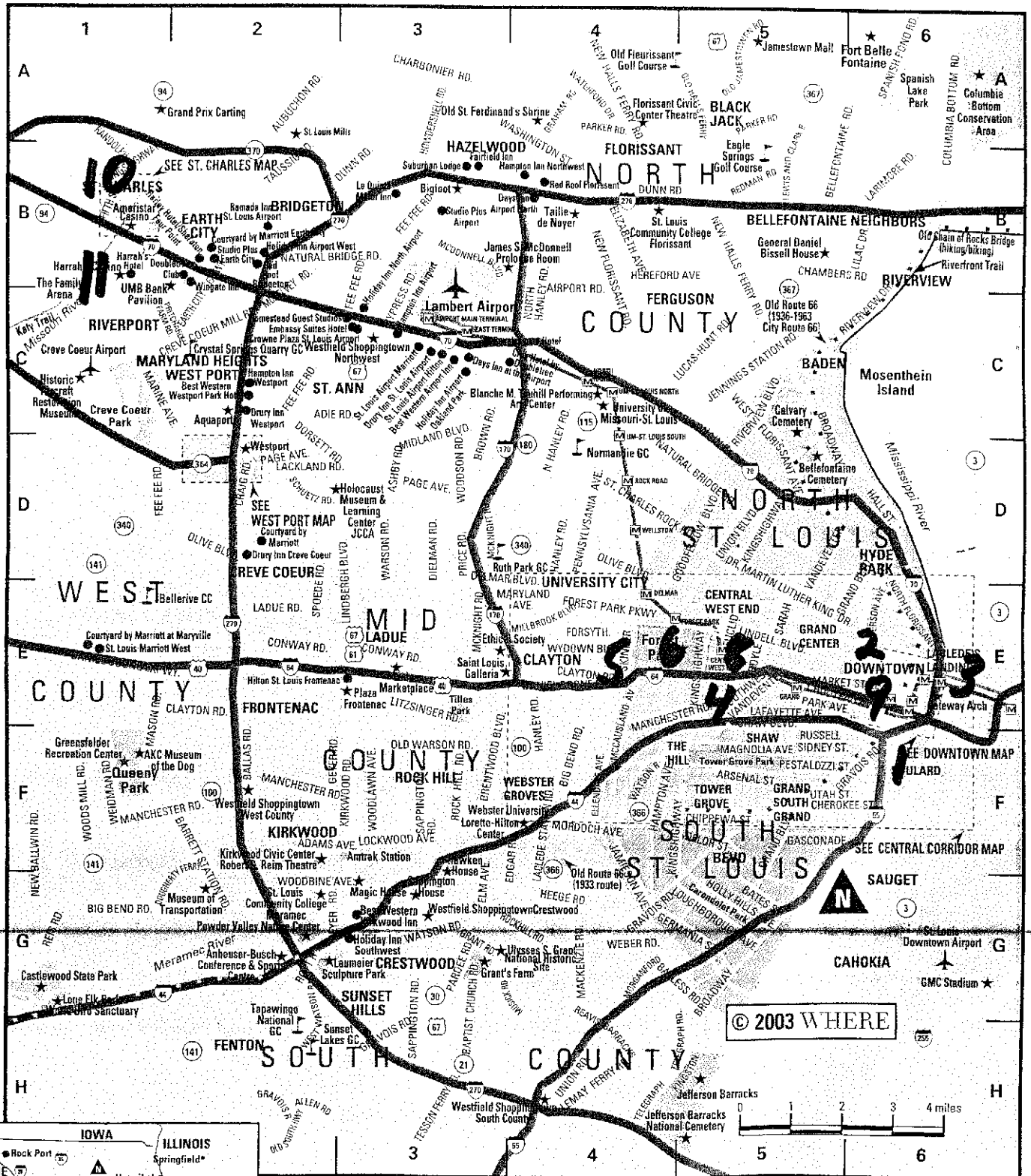

MetroLink light rail system travels 35 miles from Lambert Airport to Belleville, Illinois, from approximately 5:30 a.m. to midnight, Mon.-Sat.; Sun. 6 a.m.-11 p.m. Fare from Lambert Airport stations \$3 for adults; \$1.50 for seniors, children, disabled. From all other stations, adult fare \$1.25; with transfer \$1.50. Seniors, children, disabled fare 60¢; with transfer 75¢. Tickets available at Ticket Vending Machines (TVM) at all stations. Multi-ride tickets and tickets purchased elsewhere must be time-and-date stamped at the station in the red validator before boarding. Travel on MetroLink is free between Laclede's Landing and Union Station, Mon-Fri., 11 a.m.-1 p.m. Bicycles are allowed on MetroLink.
